The new Royal Canadian Mounted Police Detachment, being constructed just north of the current detachment, will house both municipal and provincial funded RCMP units and support staff. The Net-Zero Ready, 3-storey building will utilize BC-sourced Nail Laminated Timber, and allows the City to showcase our commitment to energy conservation and innovative building practices.

Week of January 11, 2021 Update

Since the December 7, 2020 Update, the following activities have occurred:

- Installation of structrural steel, brace bays and first floor columns
- Continued off-site fabrication of mass timber panels
- Delivery of additional structural steel and joists
- Floor joist installation for northern portion of the building
