Re: Liquor Control and Licensing Act **Application for Liquor Primary Licence**

The Applicant, **North Peace Cultural Society**, located at 10015 – 100th Avenue in Fort St. John, has applied for a Liquor Primary Licence for the North Peace Cultural Centre. The proposed application would allow the ability to provide liquor service during special events such as theatre shows, gallery openings or upon requests from renters within individual rooms while still allowing and encouraging minors to utilize the facility.
