
ZONING AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 2576, 2023

DATE: Monday, February 13, 2023 at 6 pm LOCATION: City Hall, 10631 100 Street

Fort St. John City Council will be considering a Zoning Bylaw Amendment for 9704 101 Avenue, legally described as Lot 23, Section 6, Township 84, Range 18, West of the Sixth Meridian, Peace River District Plan 4252.

The City of Fort St. John received an application to amend the Zoning of the property from RM-2 Multiple Dwelling Housing (High Density) to C-2 Downtown Core Commercial.

This amendment will allow for the consolidation of four undersized commercial lots into one large commercial lot that will support the development of an appropriately scaled multi-tenant commercial building containing office and retail uses, as per the current C-2 Downtown Core Commercial requirements. The three lots adjacent to this parcel, to the West, are currently zoned C-2.



Copies of the administration report that includes the background information and proposed permit may be inspected during regular working hours of 8:30 am to 4:30 pm at City Hall, 10631-100 Street, Fort St. John, BC starting at noon on February 9, 2023.
