- \* There is no fee but registration is required.
- \* Only one category per entry allowed. There is no limit on family and children 12 and under.
- \* The entire gingerbread “house” must be built of edible materials. Other non-edible structures can be added.
- \* Drop off your Gingerbread house at the Peace North Gallery (located inside North Peace Cultural Centre) on December 3 from 4-7pm.
- \* Entries need to be on a base no bigger than 20 x 18”
- \* This year’s theme is “**Community Spirit**”. Bonus points if you can incorporate what makes Fort St. John a vibrant community.
- \* Please enter your first name and category on the bottom of the base (out of view).
- \* Judging will be on the same day (December 3) at 7pm and winners will be announced afterwards around 8pm.
- \* If winners are not in attendance they can pick up their prize at the North Peace Cultural Centre Box office during business hours.
- \* The houses will be on display for the rest of the week for viewing. Please pick up your entry no later than December 11 at 5pm; otherwise it will be disposed of.
- \* North Peace Cultural Centre Box Office is open Monday to Friday 9am-5pm.
- \* The City of Fort St John, North Peace Cultural Centre, Bounce and Move Media are not responsible for damages to entries.
