## PERMISSIVE TAX EXEMPTION BYLAW NO. 2621, 2025

In accordance with Section 227 of the Community Charter, public notice is given that the City of Fort St. John Council will consider adopting Permissive Tax Exemption Bylaws No. 2620, 2025 and 2621, 2025 at their Regular Meeting on Monday, September 8, 2025 at 3 pm in Council Chambers inside City Hall (10631 100 Street, Fort St. John, BC).

### **City of Fort St. John (North Peace Cultural Society Management Agreement)**

#### **Permissive Tax Exemption Bylaw No. 2620, 2025**

City of Fort St. John (North Peace Cultural Society Management Agreement) Permissive Tax Exemption Bylaw No. 2620, 2025 exempts the lands and improvements of roll numbers 6539.000 and 556.000 (civic addresses: 10015 – 100 Avenue and 10015 – 99 Avenue). The exemptions are for the taxation years of 2026, 2027, and 2028. The estimated amount that would be imposed on the properties if not exempt is \$115,352.05 annually for the years 2026, 2027, and 2028.

### **City of Fort St. John (Fort St. John Curling Club Management Agreement)**

#### **Permissive Tax Exemption Bylaw No. 2621, 2025**

City of Fort St. John (Fort St. John Curling Club Management Agreement) Permissive Tax Exemption Bylaw No. 2621, 2025 exempts the lands and improvements of roll number 8650.000 (civic address: 9504 – 96 Street). The exemption is for the taxation years of 2026 and 2027. The estimated amount that would be imposed on the property if not exempt is \$45,681.02 for the years 2026 and 2027.
