Open Oval

It's more than just a skating surface. At Open Oval, take a leisurely ride on a bike, strider, scooter, skateboard or rollerblades. This is the perfect environment for toddlers to learn to ride a bike. *These sessions are strictly for riding. Tricks on ramps/rails are not permitted. Motorized equipment such as E-bikes and hover boards is not permitted.*

Court Sports

Users can enjoy either pickleball or badminton. Pickleball is a low-impact sport that blends elements of table tennis and badminton, played with a paddle and a wiffleball. Nets will be set up, and rule signage will be posted for those looking to learn. Clean indoor shoes are required, and equipment can be signed out at the Visitor Centre. Want more court time? Talk to our staff about booking a court on a day that works for you! *No sessions on Saturday, June 27 for the annual Ball Hockey tournament.*

Drop In Adult Roller Hockey (16+)

Get ready to roll! Nets and balls will be provided, but participants must bring their own equipment such as rollerblades, sticks, gloves, and helmets. Helmets are mandatory and additional gear such as gloves, shin pads, and elbow pads are highly recommended. Scrimmages may be played here, but slapshots and body contact are not permitted. Rollerblades are required. Please ensure your wheels are clean and tape is removed from sticks. Check in at the front desk/Visitor Centre for your wrist band before heading to the floor. Limited sticks and goalie gear is available to borrow for no additional cost.

Equipment Borrowing

Sign out pickleball, badminton, basketball or table tennis equipment at the Visitor Centre. **Please note:** gear loan is only available during Visitor Centre hours. Users are welcome to bring their own basketballs, paddles, and ping pong balls outside of gear loan hours.
